Lessons from Narnia

We are well on our way into another school year. Assignments are coming and going, students are learning. What I always enjoy is the chance to introduce the students to Narnia.

The 'Chronicles of Narnia' are a series of seven books that CS Lewis wrote to help children, or the childlike, to get to know God better. C.S. Lewis continues to intrigue me with his insights into life. Edmund, in the story 'The Lion, the Witch, and the Wardrobe' has been a self-centered boy who has only thought of himself. It is beyond him to think that there is another point of view than his own. He is spiteful to his younger sister Lucy, and when both of them get into Narnia, he lies about visiting Narnia. He betrays his brother and sisters to the white witch, who is planning to kill them. Once Edmund is rescued by Aslan and forgiven, the price of betrayal which is death, still must be paid. Aslan agrees to take Edmund's place and is killed in his place. The part that has intrigued me this time through the story is that once Edmund meets Aslan all he does from that point on is look at Aslan's face. He does not look at the evil queen when she comes to claim Edmund's life. All Edmund does or can do is look at Aslan's face.

This is a beautiful picture of what we need to do in all of life, look at Jesus' face. Keep our eyes off of all the things that can distract us and focus on Him. This is what it means to walk with God and experience His presence.
